

## JESUS, THE KING **OF MERCIFUL LOVE**



loday is the solemnity of Christ the King. Who is your master? Who is your king? In today's Gospel one of the criminals crucified with Jesus acknowledges Him as King, while the other scorns Him. Is the life you are living right now an acknowledgment, or is it an insult to Christ's kingship?

It is to note that during the crucifixion, "the people stood by and watched." It is sad that a lot of us seem not to care anymore about social issues, as long as we are "safe". And so we just stand by and watch. Disgusting. Pathetic. Sad.

Somewhere along the way, you and I must take a stand: either we are for Christ or against Christ. Insofar as we do good, we help perpetuate Christ's kingdom. Insofar as we do bad, we help perpetuate the reign of Satan. Are you an agent of Christ, or an agent of the evil one?

How will it be when you and I will face Christ the King someday? Will we face Him in shame knowing that we have abandoned Him? Or will we face Him in humility and gratitude knowing that somehow we have done our best for Him?

As we come to the last Sunday in our liturgical year, perhaps it would be good to reflect on a text message I received about the "four blessed looks": LOOK BACK and thank God; LOOK FORWARD and trust God: LOOK AROUND and serve God; LOOK WITHIN and find God.

A reading rom the second book of Samuel All the tribes of Israel came to David at Hebron. 'Look' they said 'we are your own flesh and blood. In days past when Saul was our king, it was you who led Israel in all their exploits; and the Lord said to you, "You are the man who shall be shepherd of my people Israel, you shall be the leader of Israel." So all the elders of Israel came to the king at Hebron, and King David made a pact with them at Hebron in the presence of the Lord, and they anointed David king of Israel.


